- **FAMILIES IMPACT**
- MFS has supported families by preventing families and individuals from becoming homeless; Providing them with critically needed support services in a timely manner; including employment assistance, expungements, auto repairs, transportation, rental assistance, drug counseling and medical/ mental health services, emergency rental payments, homeless rent and deposit support, housing search, holistically supporting the family unit with case management, needs assessment, budgeting and with direct referrals.
- **YOUTH IMPACT**
- MFS has a positive impact on youth; members of at-risk families, by preventing them from becoming homeless; providing critically-needed support services in a timely manner, including drug counseling, education, training/employment, case management and mental health counseling.
- **ADVOCACY FOR AT-RISK**
- MFS has had a positive impact on families by teaching them how to maneuver through the County safety-net resource agencies to prevent them from becoming homeless, and teach them how to advocate for their family; adults, youth and children.
